The feature set included: Embedded FIPS 140-2 compliant SSL subsystem, updated cellular data card drivers (as from Sierra Wireless, Sprint 597e, AT&T Option GT Max 3.6 and GC89), embedded support for TAIP-formatted GPS output and multi-target GPS delivery (optional GPS required).

"The core system was recompiled with a FIPS 140-2 compliant SSL module because Nexus takes information security seriously," said Evhen Tupis, who leads the Product management team.

In regard to the GPS enhancements, Gary Boone, a Nexus Channel Sales Manager noted, "Having NMEA-0183 support was good. With TAIP added, the Nexus Hawk is natively compatible with an even larger number of standards-based AVL and tracking systems." With "multi-target GPS delivery", the Nexus Hawk may also send the same GPS information to several target-hosts at the same time.
